Works in progress WILL NOT be accepted.

Films must have been completed before the submission **deadline** of **May 30, 2019**.

Films should be 6 minutes or less

To enter film in more than one category, you must use a separate entry form. Each film must be submitted on its own and with its own form. You can submit the film along with the application via email to WestCovinaFilmFestival@gmail.com.

All submitted materials become property of West Covina Film Festival and Youth Film Productions. By submitting an Entry, you hereby grant to the Festival a royalty-free, fully paid up, perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive and fully sub-licensable right and license to use, reproduce, modify, adapt, publish, translate, combine with other works, create derivative works from, distribute, perform, edit and display such Entry (in whole or part) including, without limitation, the names and likenesses of any persons or locations embodied therein, and/or to incorporate it in other works in any form, media, or technology now known or later developed.
